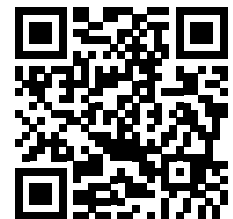

Open Class Building Hours: 10am - 9pm, daily.

Important Dates -

Pre-Registration Deadline: Mon., July 21st 9:00pm
Entry Day (Except Flowers): Tues., July 22nd 8:00am - 6:00pm
Judging (Flowers): Wed., July 23rd 6:00pm
Judging: Wed., July 23rd starts at 8:00am
Release/Pick-Up: Sun., July 27th 4:00pm - 6:00pm

Entry Day Instructions -

1. Enter through front gate (no parking fees on Tuesday)
2. You may park in front of the Open Class Building to unload, then move your vehicle after.
3. Pre-registration is recommended to make Entry Day easier. We highly recommend anyone with 10 entries or more to pre-register. If you have not pre-registered, please have your items: Department, Division, and Class numbers upon arrival.
4. Registration closes at **6:00pm on Tues, for all areas.**

Regulations -

- **Only one entry in a class will be permitted by an exhibitor.** In case of duplicate entries by the same exhibitor, neither exhibit will qualify for judging.
- Entries are required to be made in the owner's name only. However, entries may be brought for competition by another individual or group
- The same exhibit may not be entered for premiums more than 1 year; entries should be from the current year.
- Entries are required to be delivered and remain on exhibit as designated by individual departments.
- A superintendent has the authority to reject an entry based on entry requirements.
- The same photograph cannot be used in multiple divisions or classes.
- All photographs should be 5x7, matted or mounted on tag/foam board and ready to hang including a label with name, address and phone number on the back.
- The department will make every effort to assure the safety of all articles after arrival and placement, but **in no event will the department be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits.**

Judging -

- Buildings are closed to the exhibitors and the general public during judging. An exhibitor is not allowed to discuss or influence a judge's decision. The entry will be disqualified if this occurs.
- Judges' decisions are final.



Premiums -

- Premiums will be paid when entries are picked up on the last day of the Fair or at the discretion of the board. **Premiums will be forfeited for any entries removed prior to Sunday, July 27th before 4:00pm.**
- Sponsor gifts are awarded to Grand and Reserve Grand Champion, Champion and Reserve Champion as specified by donor.

Premiums: 1st: \$4.00; 2nd: \$3.00; 3rd: \$2.00

NEXT STEPS TO REGISTER FOR YOUR FAIR

1. Register (create) an exhibitor
 2. Add entries to that exhibitor.
 3. Repeat for additional exhibitors and/or entries.
 4. Resolve any registration issues (look for the blue notices)
- When done with exhibitors and entries, click "Continue to Payment" and submit the "Invoice".
(There are no fees or payments needed, but this step is required to complete your registration.)

LOGGING BACK IN ANOTHER TIME

When logging back in, you will find your family profile in either of these "situations":

- Invoice un-submitted - You can continue adding or completing entries on that invoice.
- Invoice submitted and approved - You can add entries by starting a new invoice.

NAVIGATION HINTS

Click on the fair "Title" to return to your family Dashboard at any time. When working on an invoice, you can often click on any of the navigation buttons even if they are not green. This can be helpful for going "back and forth" while working on entries.

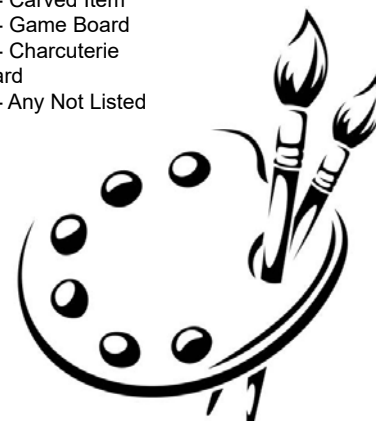

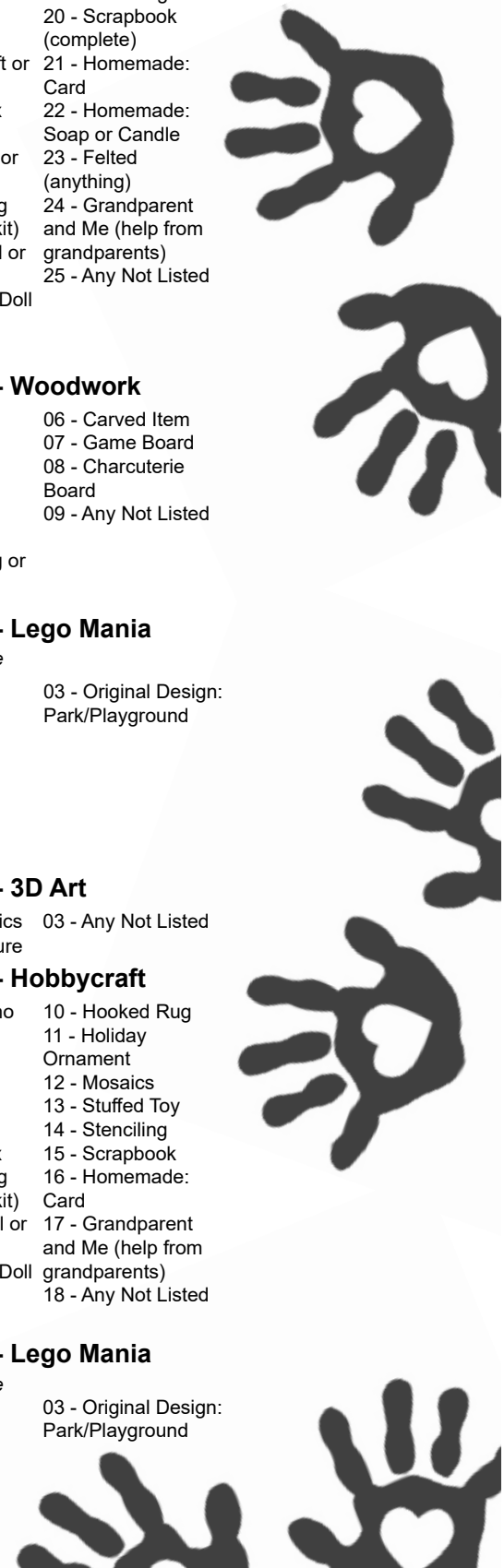
